

STREET PROJECTS SCHEDULED

After a rough winter, there are plenty of potholes that need patched in town. That work will take place as soon as the weather breaks. We will also repair/replace damaged storm grates. The storm drains will also be cleaned out and brought up to grade to ensure runoff water can drain properly.

SIGN UP FOR BELMONT COUNTY CodeRED

Morristown uses Belmont County CodeRED to send notifications to residents about water main breaks and other general and emergency situations. If you are not signed up to receive these notifications by phone, email, text or a free mobile app, please do so. It's free to register and your personal information is kept confidential. Text "BELMONT" to 99411 to sign up or call Belmont County 9-1-1 at 740-695-9104 Monday through Friday, 8:30 to 4:30.

NEW ADDITIONS TO YOUR PROPERTY

Just a friendly reminder: You must apply for a zoning permit and follow Village Ordinance 12-14 when building a new addition to your property, like a fence, shed, garage or room addition. Call the Village Administrator or log onto www.morristownohio.org for zoning ordinance info.

OPEN BURNING PROHIBITED

Per village ordinance, open burning is prohibited at all times within Morristown Corporation Limits. You are permitted to enjoy campfires in a fire ring or firepit. We ask that you position it where the smoke/smell will least likely blow onto your neighbor's property.

Wildfire danger is high in spring before plants have turned green and warm, windy weather also contributes to fire risk. Never leave a campfire unattended.
